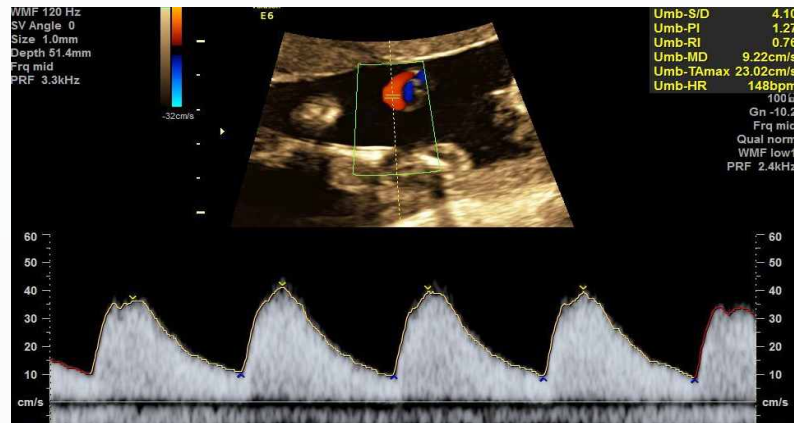

# First Of It's Kind

We take great pleasure in inviting you to a 2 days conference on Fetal Medicine with the National faculty of Mediscan Chennai - Dr. S. Suresh and his team. This conference is dedicated to the memory of Dr A. V. Umrnikar, a leading Obstetrician & Gynecologist, who was a guide and taught generations of ObGyns in Pune.

The scientific program will be of practical benefit for Obstetricians to understand what to expect from Ultrasound reports and how to counsel and decisively manage pregnant women based on it. It will also benefit Radiologists and Obstetricians doing Ultrasound scans to understand the standards of reporting in clear, informative, medico-legally safe and actionable terms.

Not uncommonly there are grey areas that make it difficult to make binary decisions, before and after the 20 weeks deadline. For example, indirect evidence of some evolving CNS and cardiac anomalies can be tricky to report and decisions have to be made based on inadequate information. Fetal abnormalities can show up later in pregnancy can be missed and lead to unnecessary neonatal morbidity when one is unprepared for special needs of such a fetus at birth. Understanding, evaluating, reporting and counseling the expecting couple about these anomalies is a challenging task that will be covered in this conference.

Fetal growth is known to falter in 30% of pregnancies. A clear understanding of Doppler physiology, consensus definitions and staging of early and late onset fetal growth restriction can guide protocol-based timing of delivery and avert stillbirth. Increasing incidence of Gestational diabetes compels us to understand risk factors, ideal glycemic control and monitoring of fetal growth to deliver the fetus timely and avert stillbirth.

Twin pregnancies pose special challenges. Early detection of evolving complications can make it possible to refer to an appropriate fetal intervention center with the necessary expertise to save one, if not both fetuses. Understanding the nuances of reporting fetal growth in twin pregnancies, role of Doppler in detecting, triaging and staging complications and management of complications with invasive interventions will be discussed.

We feel that comprehensive elucidation of these commonly encountered issues in Fetal Medicine, by experienced faculty will bring clarity to your practice and change your approach to reporting and managing pregnancies.
